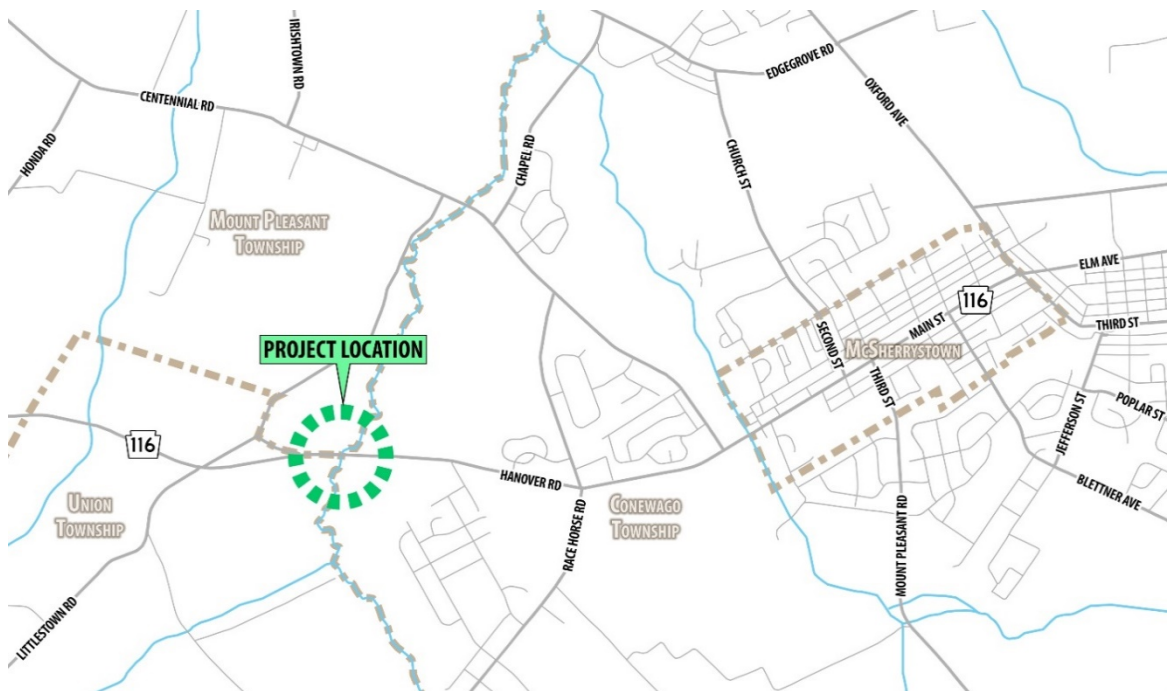


S.R. 0116 Bridge Replacement Project
Union & Conewago Townships, Adams County
Project Update – February 18, 2020

The proposed project entails the replacement of the existing structure on a similar alignment. This project is located west of McSherrystown. The bridge is located along SR 116 and crosses the South Branch of Conewago Creek with farm, industrial, and residential land uses within the area near the bridge. The existing structure carries SR 116 (Hanover Road) over the South Branch Conewago Creek in Union and Conewago Townships, Adams County. The existing structure was built in 1932, reconstructed in 1949, and is currently identified as structurally deficient. The structure has two 11-foot lanes with 4-foot shoulders. The proposed structure will provide two 11-foot lanes and 8-foot shoulders.

This project is located in the vicinity of the current Eisenhower Drive Extension Project but is a separate and stand-alone project. The bridge replacement is necessary and is proceeding regardless of the outcome of the Eisenhower Drive Extension Project.



PennDOT is currently conducting preliminary engineering efforts, including geotechnical investigations and preliminary highway and structural design. The project is scheduled to be advertised in June 2021, with construction to follow in the summer and fall of 2021.
