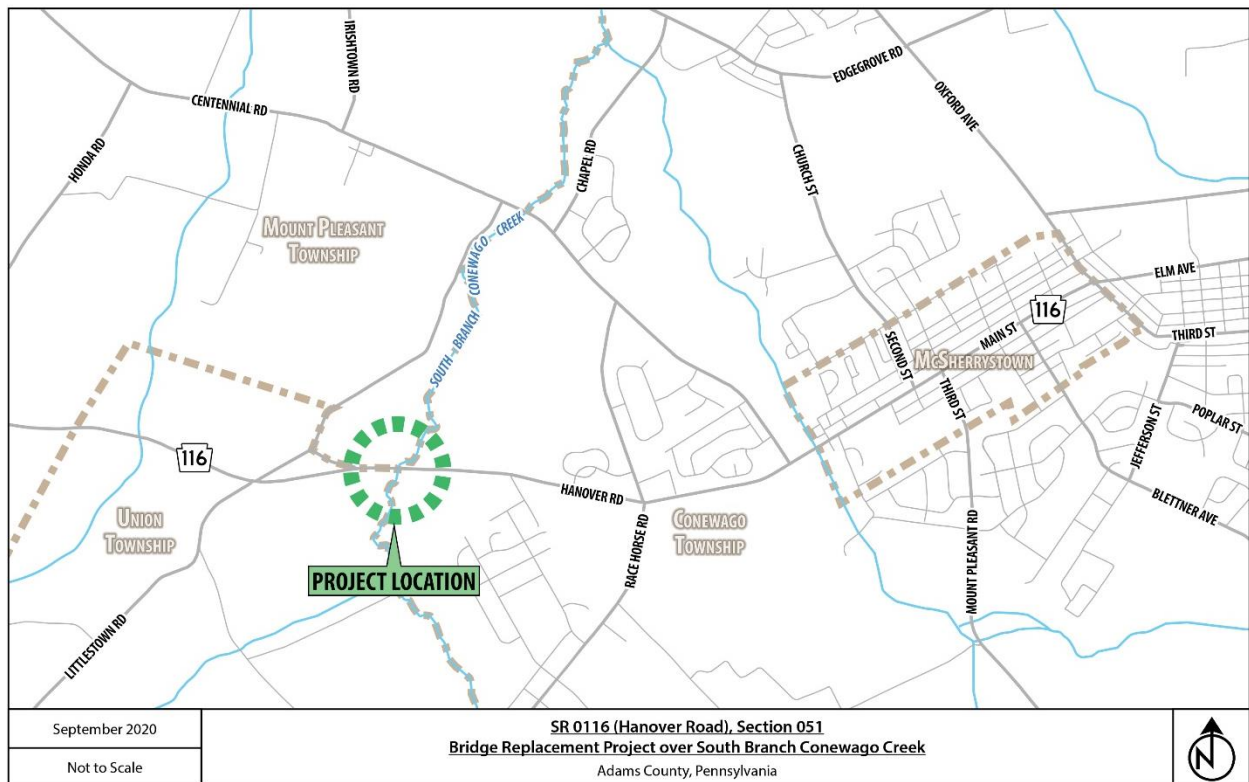


## SR 0116 Bridge Replacement Project Union & Conewago Townships, Adams County Project Update – October 2020

The project consists of the replacement of the existing SR 0116 (Hanover Road) structure over the South Branch of Conewago Creek in Union and Conewago Townships, Adams County, PA, located in an area with agricultural, industrial, and residential land uses.

The existing structure was built in 1932, reconstructed in 1949, and is currently identified as structurally deficient. The structure has two 11-foot lanes with 4-foot shoulders. The proposed structure will be on similar alignment and provides two 11-foot lanes and 8-foot shoulders.

***This project is located in the vicinity of the current Eisenhower Drive Extension Project but is a separate and stand-alone project. The bridge replacement is necessary and is proceeding regardless of the outcome of the Eisenhower Drive Extension Project.***



PennDOT is currently conducting final design efforts, including highway and structural design. Environmental Clearance was obtained in June 2020. Construction work is expected to take place in the 2022 and 2023 construction seasons.
